New service X38

From Monday 26 October 2009, we are launching this brand new service, linking Biddulph with Sandbach and Crewe for the first time. On the same day, we also take over the operation of two other routes between Sandbach and Crewe; service D1 **THE HARRIER** via Haslington and service 32 via Warmingham. Our All Day, Day Return and Ten Trip tickets can be used between common points on any of these services. That is, out by one route and back via another.

Our first X38 timetable offers options for journeys for work or shopping in Sandbach and Crewe, especially the famous Sandbach Market, held each Thursday and Saturday. We also welcome suggestions on how we could improve the service in the future.

Good connections are also available in Biddulph with bakerbus services to and from Hanley, Newcastle and Leek and in Congleton, with bakerbus services to and from Macclesfield.

bakerbus is a division of Bakers Coaches of Biddulph, a family business first established in 1936, with a reputation for quality service. 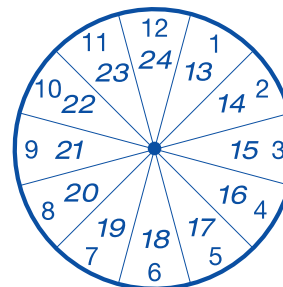

ALL DAY TICKETS

Available from the driver of any bakerbus service, for unlimited travel in Staffordshire and Cheshire on the day of issue. Adults £3.50, Children £2.00, Family £7.00 (maximum of two adults and up to three children, all travelling together).

TEN TRIP TICKETS

These enable ten single journeys to be made for much less than the price of nine, available from the driver, and now remains valid for three months after issue.

SENIOR CITIZENS

Those over 60 years of age and resident in Cheshire travel free after 0930 on Mondays to Fridays and anytime time at weekends and bank holidays, with a bus pass obtainable from your local council. This includes 'cross border' journeys to and from points in Staffordshire. Also at off-peak times, elsewhere in England, (some other areas offer free travel all day, including North Staffordshire) with a bus pass that can be obtained from your local council.
